ProStart Culinary	Culinary will be held at scheduled times in person if possible. Schools will be allowed to submit a virtual submission if travel is not permitted or it is not safe to hold the in-person event at that time.
ProStart Management	ProStart Management will be held in a hybrid format with scheduled times over live video conferencing.
Baking and Pastry	Baking and Pastry will be held at scheduled times in person if possible. Schools will be allowed to submit a virtual submission if travel is not permitted or it is not safe to hold the in-person event at that time.

*Teacher Registration: Under participant type, select **ProStart teacher (not registering for FCCLA)** for all teachers and mentors attending the ProStart event*

Important information needed for on-line registration

- FCCLA students do not have to be registered for State Leadership Conference (SLC) to compete in FCCLA Culinary event only. They must be registered for FCCLA State Leadership Conference to compete in any other FCCLA event.
- You must include all student names.
- You must select the ProStart event for each student registration and then place each student on team 1 or team 2.
- Team 1 is the red team and Team 2 is the blue team for your planning purposes.
- Additional guests will be limited.
- Information entered will be used "as is" for programs, nametags, etc.
