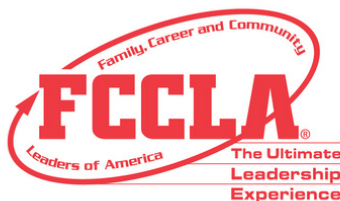

## **FULL FCCLA REGISTRATION**

Student attending state leadership conference and then pick ProStart as the competitive event  
If you have some students attending and not attending, you can follow the directions for other registrants to enter those that are not paying the FCCLA registration

## **PROSTART or BAKING ONLY REGISTRATION**

Student Registration: Under participant type, select Culinary/ProStart Non FCCLA Registrant for all students

Teacher Registration: Under participant type, select ProStart teacher (not registering for FCCLA) for all teachers and mentors attending

## **IMPORTANT REGISTRATION INFORMATION**

**REGISTRATION MUST BE SUBMITTED BY FEBRUARY 3, 2023**

FCCLA students do not have to be registered for State Leadership Conference (SLC) to compete in FCCLA Culinary or Baking and Pastry event. They must be registered for FCCLA State Leadership Conference to compete in any other FCCLA event.

- You must include all student names.
- You must select the ProStart event for each student registration and then place them on teams 1 or 2.
- Team 1 is the red team and Team 2 is the blue team for your planning purposes.
- Any adults attending must be included in your registration but their registration fee is FREE.
- Information provided will be used as entered for programs, nametags, etc.
- Baking and Pastry competitors must be affiliated FCCLA members by February 1st.
- Baking and Pastry is an individual event and three entries are eligible per chapter.
