### Guidelines

**Hurst Scholarship:** The FCCLA Hurst Scholarship is named for Miss Hortense Hurst, the supervisor of Family and Consumer Sciences for over 25 years. Miss Hurst helped start many FCCLA chapters and promoted the organization throughout the state. The FCCLA Hurst scholarship winner must be active at chapter, district, and state levels and demonstrate leadership through participation in FCCLA, community service, and school activities.

**Jeremy Jackson Scholarship:** The Jeremy K. Jackson Memorial Scholarship is presented to a high school senior who will be pursuing a bachelor's degree at a college or university. Established in 1998-1999, the scholarship is named for Jeremy K. Jackson, that year's Vice President of Membership. Jeremy's goal was to see membership in FCCLA grow across the state.

Items needed for the application:

- 200-300 word essay for the Jeremy Jackson scholarship
- Official Transcript
- Letters of Recommendation, Chapter Adviser to submit at:
